Interactive Workshops on the following topics:

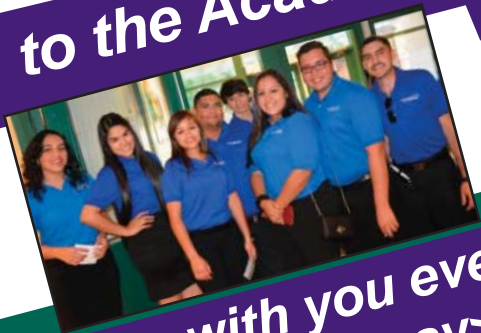
- Communicating with a Team
